1. Registration

a) Trap

- i. Fill out the 2020 registration form on the www.hastingshighschooltrapteam.com website "registration" page and select the "submit registration" button.
- ii. Log into ClayTargetGO on mnclaytarget.com website and create/update your profile. (**team ID: has035**)
- iii. Trap team head coach will process the shooter registration with the MN clay target league.
- iv. An email will be sent to the shooter (address on file) with instructions on completing the MN clay target league registration.

b) Skeet

- i. Any shooters that would like to participate on the skeet team must contact Darin Berg directly to determine if there is a position available on the team.
 - ❖ must be at least a second year shooter & you do not need to shoot both trap & skeet
- ii. Log into ClayTargetGO on mnclaytarget.com website and create/update your profile. (**team ID: has035**)
- iii. Head skeet coach will process the shooter registration with the MN clay target league.
- iv. An email will be sent to the shooter (address on file) with instructions on completing the MN clay target league registration.
