Fitting a Gun

First you must determine which eye is the dominant one.

Second, check to see that Length of Pull is correct. With eyes closed, mount the gun. Hold the grip and measure the distance from the knuckle on the thumb to your nose. Should be between $1\,\%$ and 2 inches.

Then, mount and shoot at a target plate or paper without looking at the bead two or three times to check where the gun patterns. Do this from 16 yards. To move pattern 1" adjust stock 1/16".

Center of pattern high, need to lower the comb. Can be adjusted with wedge where stock meets the receiver, or could lengthen the stock.

Center of pattern low, need to raise the comb. Can be adjusted with wedge where stock meets the receiver, done with moleskin, adjustable comb, or by shortening the stock.
